REAL TALK FROM THE WORD

Original sin:

Ps 51:5 (NASB) - Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, And in sin my mother conceived me.

1Co 15:21-22 (NASB) - For since by a man came death, by a man also came the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ all will be made alive.

Heb 8:12 (NASB) - "FOR I WILL BE MERCIFUL TO THEIR INIQUITIES, AND I WILL REMEMBER THEIR SINS NO MORE."

What are some of the words people use to lessen the severity of sin?

READ ROMANS 1:18-25 – Describe the severity nature of sin, according to this passage.

Forgiveness helps us understand and see most clearly who God is.

WHAT GOD FORGIVES US OF:

- *Inquiry* is a premeditated choice that carries with it some continuing disregard for repentance.
- *Transgression* is presumptuous sin, arrogant sin. This is to choose to willfully disobey.
- Sin is to miss the mark.

Sin carries with it collateral damage. When you sin against God, you also sin against others.

- SYMMETRY (Balance): You must embrace and believe that you can be forgiven.
- CLARITY: There is no iniquity, transgression, or sin that is more powerful than the forgiveness of God in Christ. Forgiveness of others is a command.
- COMMUNITY: If you and I want to walk in the communion of the saints, then confession of sins is an ongoing ethics of what happens.
- COUNSEL: If I can be mindful of how God's forgiven me, then I am able to extend forgiveness to others. God loves to wipe away debts and break all the rules of a punishment-obsessed world.
